







Fewer 53% than boys (58%) transition to secondary.


Fewer 79% than boys (81%) complete lower secondary.

63% compared to men **37**%



Number of maternal deaths since (2000-2020).





Maternal mortality ratio (modelled estimate, per 100,000 live births)




Maternal mortality ratio in Uganda declined by

Births attended by skilled personnel


